

# TRENTON GOLF CLUB SENIOR MEN'S LEAGUE 2023

Tee time Tuesdays at 1:00 PM tee

**Formats:** Stroke play will be the most common format. Handicaps will be calculated weekly.

**Stroke Play:** Count all strokes taken to record a total nine-hole score. Handicaps will be subtracted by the committee to calculate your net score.

**Weekly Prizes:** Each week prizes will be awarded on an individual basis to the top golfers

**Handicaps:** Handicaps are calculated for the league and are based on scores for nine holes. The handicaps will be calculated every week using a system similar to the OGA.

<b>Points Awarded:</b> 1 <sup>st</sup> place net	4 points
2 <sup>nd</sup> place net	3 points
1 <sup>st</sup> place gross	2 points
Side contest	1 point
Attendance	2 points

The points will accumulate through the season and prizes will be awarded at the closing banquet to persons with the highest number of points.

This is a fun league, but we take golf seriously. Winter rules apply to the fairways only. In the rough, play the ball as it lies unless it is dangerous. There are no gimmes.

## Weekly Money Allocation

If 1 person wins 1<sup>st</sup> place 60% and 2<sup>nd</sup> 40%

If 2 persons tie for 1<sup>st</sup> 40% to each & 20% to 2<sup>nd</sup> place

If 3 persons tie for 1<sup>st</sup> split 3 ways, 0 to 2<sup>nd</sup> place

## **Changes for 2023:**

1. For the 2023 season the payout will be to the top 15 golfers.
2. If you do not intend to play, you cannot pay the daily fee and get attendance points.
3. Points will be accumulated until the week before closing but will not be disclosed for the four weeks before closing and there will not be a spreadsheet on the registration desk during the last four weeks.
4. Points will be given for winners in the following manner
  - a. 1<sup>st</sup> place net                      4 points
  - b. 2<sup>nd</sup> place net                      3 points
  - c. 1<sup>st</sup> place gross                    2 points
  - d. Closest to the pin                1 point for each hole

Note: If the 1<sup>st</sup> place gross happens to win the 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> place net, he will receive 4 or 3 points but NOT the additional 2 points for being the 1<sup>st</sup> place gross.

## **Rain or stormy weather:**

During the 2022 season we had a couple of days when the weather presented a problem. Here are the rules we will follow in 2023. The committee will always be thinking of your safety first.

1. Rain or shine, players should be ready to play.
2. If the radar map forecast indicates pre-game lightning, the committee will decide before 12:40 whether to play the game or not. If the game does not start, points for attendance will be given to registered players and all the money will be held until the following week.
3. If lightning is threatened or observed while we are on the course, the game will be stopped. Points for attendance will be given to registered players, no prizes will be awarded and all the money will be held until the following week.
