SENIOR MEN'S LEAGUE EVERY TUESDAY

All players fifty years old and over are welcome.

From May 6 to October 7, 2025

Tee time at 1:00 PM and registration at the club house from 11:45am – 12:30pm

Formats: Stroke play will be the common format. Handicaps will be calculated weekly. Shot gun start is used and the hole assignment for each player will be announced outside the club house before deployment.

Stroke Play: Count all strokes taken to record a total nine-hole score. Handicaps will be subtracted by the committee to calculate your net score.

Handicaps: Handicaps are calculated for the league and are based on scores for nine holes. The handicaps will be calculated using a system similar to the OGA.

Points Awarded: 1 st place net	4 points
2 nd place net	3 points
1 st place gross	2 points
Closest to the pin	1 point
- All players from red tees 2 & 8	
Attendance	2 points

Note: If the 1st place gross happens to win the 1st or 2nd place net, he will receive 4 or 3 points but NOT the additional 2 points for being the 1st place gross.

The points will accumulate through the season. Prizes will be awarded at the closing banquet to the 15 persons with the highest number of points; three of which will be the top players with a final handicap of 18.

This is a fun league, but we take golf seriously and therefore all official golf rules apply. As with all golf, the honor system is paramount. We trust everyone to keep honest scores and use proper etiquette on the course. Winter rules apply to the fairways only. In the rough, play the ball as it lies unless it is dangerous. There are no gimmies when putting. Each player must complete by putting the ball in the hole and count each stroke or be marked on the card as DNF (Did Not Finish).

Fees: Yearly registration of \$35, which pays for the year end meal and prizes.
Weekly \$4

Weekly Prize Money Allocation

\$1 is saved and accumulated for a local charity and another \$1 for year end prizes. Each weekly prize will be awarded on an individual basis to the top golfers.

If 1 person wins 1st place 30% and 2nd 20%

If 2 persons tie for 1st 20% to each & 10% to 2nd place

If 3 persons tie for 1st split 3 ways, 0 to 2nd place

Closest to the pin from red tees on holes 2 & 8, each get 25%

Notable rules for 2025:

1. Players eighty years old and over have the option to play all holes from the red tees.
2. To speed up the game and help scoring, players with a handicap of 18 have the option to pickup their ball at three strokes over par.
3. The end of year prize payout will include the top three players with a final handicap of 18.
4. If you do not intend to play, you cannot pay the daily fee and get attendance points.

Rain or stormy weather:

In the past we had some days when the weather presented a problem. Here are the rules we will follow going forward. The committee will always be thinking of your safety first.

1. Rain or shine, players should be ready to play.
2. If the radar map forecast indicates pre-game lightning, it will decide before 12:40 whether to play the game or not. If the game does not start, points for attendance will be given to registered players and all the money will be held until the following week.
3. If lightning is threatened or observed while we are on the course, the game will be stopped. Points for attendance will be given to registered players, no prizes will be awarded and all the money will be held until the following week.
